

Burton in Lonsdale Emergency Plan

Welcome to the emergency plan page. The plan was developed in 2010 to ensure the village had the resilience to withstand an incident of any kind. It has been used several times on minor incidents such as flooding, long term power outages and bad weather. It has also been tested on two occasions with the local rescue team.

The document is primarily scenario based. By looking at the index for an item such as flooding, it will take you to the relevant page with what to do and contact numbers to ring.

There is a large amount of information in the appendix, with more contact details, Goods vehicle plate meanings, available camping gear from scouts etc.

The document is updated fully every 2 years and any revisions highlighted in yellow. The Parish Council have the overall responsibility for the document, and any comments to them will be sent to the document manager for inclusion or correction.

Copies are held by council members and one in the shop. The emergency plan has been vetted and highly praised by the emergency management team of Yorkshire and Lancashire.

There is a store of emergency equipment in the rear of the garage behind the shop, including sandbags, yellow jackets, helmets etc. Salt is also available there for pavements.
